

SELECTION CRITERIA (GRADE LIST)

- 1) Applicants' artworks with high scores over 70 points out of 100 will be selected.
- 2) Artwork must be unpublished both domestically and internationally.
- 3) An average point will be calculated by subtracting the highest and lowest judge scores (or, if multiple, only one of them).
- 4) Applicants need to follow any indications from the host, depending on the circumstances.
- 5) Any problem that could occur while making the artworks, such as illegal use and plagiarism of artworks, portrait rights of a third person, copyrights, or defamation, is the responsibility of the participants, and if any of these problems are found after winning the prize, the prize may be canceled and prize money may be retrieved.
