Resolution on artistic education

We refer to the 2004 study by Ann Bamford, the “*Wow Factor*” (1), a global research compendium on the impact of art in education. This study, realized in almost 60 countries, shows that if art is involved in education, this is not only important for the development and the identity of children and young children, but it has also a positive impact on the learning curve of other disciplines such as natural sciences, history, mathematics, etc.

And it also contributes to the next generation becoming better and more creative human beings, and better citizens.

IAA AIAP asks the national governments to take this study into consideration and to include it into the education legislative procedures.

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
